Awards:

Two \$300.00 Scholarships will be awarded to one boy and one girl along with a Miniature TR Memorial Ball

The youth bowler who applies for this scholarship will need to be someone who represents Tony Reyes and the principles he stood for in life. Tony believed in the principle of giving back to the bowling community and paying forward for what he received in return. He also had a great attitude towards others. This scholarship is for the bowler that does it for the love of the game not the fame.

Eligibility:

1. Must currently be a Nor Cal YBA member in good standing.
2. Must not have been a previous recipient of this award. (see awards above).
3. Must currently be enrolled in High School or in an approved educational institute.
4. Cumulative grade point average must be at least a 2.0 or higher.

Scholarship Policy:

Your scholarship funds are available from the date of your high school graduation, or if you have already graduated, from the date you won the scholarship until your 22nd birthday.

You may use your scholarship at the following approved educational institutions; accredited universities and colleges, business schools, continuing educational courses, educational camps (such as math, science, art or computer), professional development seminars and workshops, technical schools and trade schools, and vocational schools. Nor Cal must approve the eligibility of all requests and all decisions are final.

The scholarship funds may be used for; tuition fees, housing fees, meal plans, books necessary for the successful completion of a course or program.

This scholarship will be administered by Nor Cal BC. Such scholarship must be paid directly to the accredited college or other accredited institution of higher learning of the recipient's choice, upon acceptance by that institution..

Requirements:

1. ALL INFORMATION MUST BE COMPLETED IN FULL! NO CRITERIA POINTS WILL BE AWARDED FOR INCOMPLETE INFORMATION.
2. A copy of School Transcripts for grades 9th, 10th, 11th, & 12th or Approved educational institute, MUST ACCOMPANY THIS FORM.
3. Personal References – 1 letter of recommendation from the bowling center (coach, youth director or representative of the house) explaining why you should receive this scholarship.
4. A written essay telling the committee why you deserve this scholarship. Please attach all letters of reference to the back of this form.
