

## **Nor Cal Bowling Centers**

The Nor Cal BC YBA Youth Committee will be announcing All Star selections June 19th. The Nor Cal Youth Committee has revised the selections and to adjust for the number of bowlers in each division they have along with the Nor Cal Board of Directors decided that the following the number of bowler selected shall now be no more than: 5 Bantams in each Girls and Boys Divisions and no more than 10 Boys and Girls in each of the Prep, Junior and Major Divisions.

In the case of a tie in the ninth or tenth place of any division, it is at the discretion of the Youth Committee to either accept or deny all nominations affected by the tie.

If the committee finds it is not necessary to give 70 spots, they can give the spots they feel warrants this award.

Nor Cal BC ALL STAR POINT SYSTEM

(Revised 4/2019)

Mandatory Tournaments: These three tournaments all require mandatory participation.

Junior/Adult:	10pts - Top Individual Scratch Score 7 pts - 2 <sup>nd</sup> Highest Individual Scratch Score 5 pts - 3rd Highest Individual Scratch Score 4 pts - 4 <sup>th</sup> - 8 <sup>th</sup> Highest Individual Scratch Score 3 pts - 9 <sup>th</sup> - 15 <sup>th</sup> Highest Individual Scratch Score 2 pts - For Averaging within your division's tournament scale. Team Event is not a requirement for All Stars
Youth Doubles:	10pts - Top Individual Scratch Score 7 pts - 2 <sup>nd</sup> Highest Individual Scratch Score 5 pts - 3rd Highest Individual Scratch Score 4 pts - 4 <sup>th</sup> - 8 <sup>th</sup> Highest Individual Scratch Score 3 pts - 9 <sup>th</sup> - 15 <sup>th</sup> Highest Individual Scratch Score 2 pts - For Averaging within your division's tournament scale.
NC State:	10 pts - Top Individual Scratch Score 7 pts - 2 <sup>nd</sup> Highest Individual Scratch Score 5 pts - 3rd Highest Individual Scratch Score 4 pts - 4 <sup>th</sup> - 8 <sup>th</sup> Highest Individual Scratch Score 3 pts - 9 <sup>th</sup> - 15 <sup>th</sup> Highest Individual Scratch Score 2 pts - For Averaging within your division's tournament scale. These points are for all 3 events plus All Events.

Tournament Average Division Scale:

BONUS 5 POINTS: Composite average includes all state finals scores

Bantams:	Boys: 120 and up composite average Girls: 110 and up composite average
Preps:	Boys: 150 and up composite average Girls: 140 and up composite average
Juniors:	Boys: 185 and up composite average Girls: 170 and up composite average
Majors:	Boys: 200 and up composite average Girls: 180 and up composite average

## League Statistics: (Maximum of 4 points)

<u>Includes all Nor Cal YBA certified leagues and travel leagues only.</u> Summer Leagues 2020 - YBA certified only Winter/Spring Leagues 2021-2022 - YBA certified only Composite of League and Travel League Attendance - List total number of games possible minus the total number of games bowled - computer automatically figures the percentage of attendance.

Attendance Scale:	100% Attendance:	4 pts.
	95% - 99%:	3 pts.
	<b>90% - 94</b> %	2 pts.
	<b>80% - 89%</b>	1 pt.

In-House Participation: (Maximum of 4 points) Number of league games bowled during a Nor Cal YBA season. (This includes all records from YBA Summer Leagues 2021 - April 15, 2022).

Bantams:	50 games and up =	4 points
Preps:	70 games and up =	4 points
Juniors:	85 games and up =	4 points
Majors:	85 games and up =	4 points

## Most Improved: (Maximum 5 points).

Current years book average minus previous year's book average. As of April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

## Scale for Points:

Bantam & Preps:	+ 20 or more = + 15 - +19 = + 10 - +14 = + 01 - + 09 =	5 points 3 points 2 points 1 point
Juniors:	+12 or more = + 08 - + 11 = + 04 - + 07 = + 01 - + 03 =	5 points 3 points 2 points 1 point
Majors:	+10 or more = + 06 - + 09 = + 03 - + 05 = + 01 - + 02 =	5 points 3 points 2 points 1 point

High Game: (Maximum of 5 points).

After all nominations are in the program, filter up by division. Take a count of the number in each division. Divide the field by 10. <u>As of April 15, 2022</u>

Point Values:	Top Game	=	5 points each
	Next 10% of the Field	=	4 points each
	Next 10% of the Field	=	3 points each
	Next 10% of the Field	=	2 points each
	Next 10% of the Field	=	1 points each

High Series: (Maximum of 8 points).

Divided the field by division into 10 sections as done above for high game. As of April 15, 2022.

Point Values:	Top Series	=	8 points each
	Next 10% of the Field	=	6 points each
	Next 10% of the Field	=	4 points each
	Next 10% of the Field	=	3 points each
	Next 10% of the Field	=	2 points each

Book Average Achievement: (Maximum of 5 points).

Bantam Girls:	120 and up 110 - 119 100 - 109 90 - 99	= = =	5 points 3 points 2 points 1 point
