- 1. TOURNAMENT DATE & LOCATION** - Saturday, Dec 7, 2024 - Squad Time: 11:00am
Reno National Bowling Stadium
- 2. PARTICIPATION** - Bowlers must bowl in a Nor Cal BC Member Center to Participate in this event(exception of Porterville Lanes who has been a participant of the former Carey's Tour & Travel tournament for 25 years).
- 3. TOURNAMENT FORMAT** - This is a Singles Tournament with all bowlers bowling 3 games with total pinfall plus handicap determining the winners. Men & Women will compete in the same division
- 4. PRIZE FUND DISTRIBUTION** - Based on 250 Entries (\$12,500 Total with 250 Entries)

- 5. HANDICAP** - Handicap for both men and women will be 80% of 230
- 6. AVERAGE USED FOR SINGLES TOURNAMENT** - The Highest of the Following (Certified and Non- Certified Included):
 - Highest verifiable 2021-2022 average of 21 or more games
 - Highest verifiable 2022-2023 average of 21 or more games
 - Highest verifiable 2023-2024 average of 21 or more games
 If None of the above:
 - Highest verifiable 2024 Summer League average as of August 31, 2024 (minimum 21 games)
 - Highest verifiable Current League Average 21 or more games as of November 15, 2024
 - Bowlers without one of the above averages will bowl scratch.
Average verification must accompany entry. This is the bowler's responsibility and there will be no pay-off without verification.

- 7. RE-RATE**
Bowlers who have won, or expect to win cash or merchandise prizes of \$600.00 or more in a single event including All-Events in any tournament within the last 24 month period (December 7, 2022 - December 7, 2024) must provide the tournament director with the following information:
 - Name of the Tournament in which he/she has been paid or qualified for such a prize.
 - The amount of the prize.
 - The actual score(s) bowled to qualify for the prize.
 - The prize position.

A bowler must report if he/she has an accumulated average of 21 or more games of tournament play in the previous 12 months that exceeded their entering average by 10 or more pins. Any bowler who has ever been re-rated by any bowling center, tournament, or association must inform the tournament director of his/her re-rating. Any bowler who has refused a re-rate, or has been disqualified by any tournament, must report this before bowling, and will be subject to re-rating or denial of entry in this tournament. These MUST be reported to the tournament officials at the time of entry in this tournament. Failure to do this could cause disqualification in this event.

- 8. ADMINISTRATION** - This tournament shall be conducted under the supervision of Nor Cal Bowling Centers.
